

OLS Language tests (Online Linguistic Support)

We would like to announce that the International Relations Office has assigned language assessment (OLS language tests) to the following Erasmus students:

- 1) students who are going to study abroad in the first term or during the whole academic year;
- 2) students who declared one of the following languages as their language of instruction:

English, Czech, Danish, French, Greek, Spanish, Dutch, German, Portuguese, Italian or Swedish.

A link to the language assessment will be sent by the European Commission IT tool to students' email addresses in USOS system.

The link will be active until **21 July 2016**.

If your assessment result is:

1. **A1, A2 or B1** – you will automatically receive a compulsory online language course;
2. **B2 or C1** and you would like to voluntarily participate in an online language course, please email Ms. Anna Piasecka (anna.piasecka@adm.uw.edu.pl).

On your request, you can also participate in a course of the national language of the country where you are going to study, ex. if you are going to Spain to study in English and if your assessment result is B2, C1 or C2 you can request an online course of Spanish. We would like to encourage our students to use this way of improving their language competences.

Please note! If, while contacting the host university, you find out that most courses will be held in a language different from the one you declared during the qualification process, please report it to Ms. Anna Piasecka. You will then be assigned a language test in the correct language.

Please note! When you log into the OLS system for the first time, you need to declare your mobility start date and mobility end date in your user profile. The system will “know” when to send you the link to the final language assessment (the second test, at the end of your studies abroad). If you don't put the mobility dates in your user profile, the system will send you a link to the final assessment immediately after you have completed the first assessment.

Please remember that doing the OLS assessment before the mobility is necessary in order to receive the Erasmus grant. If you don't receive a link to the OLS test, please contact Ms. Anna Piasecka.

If you are going to study abroad in the second term, the link to the OLS assessment will be sent to you in November or December 2016.
