

Additional round of qualification for Erasmus scholarship
The second, IRO-run round of qualification for places remaining free
(for spring term only)

Please note!

- Students who qualify in the second round **will NOT receive Erasmus funding (they will have an Erasmus student status, without the financial grant);**

- The final decision on whether the student is ultimately accepted as an Erasmus student is **up to the host university.**

1. Terms and conditions for applicants

You can apply if:

- you have completed at least the 1st year of undergraduate studies;
- your GPA (grade point average) for the last academic year is at least **3,5**;
- you know the language of instruction at the host university at the level required by the host university;

More terms and conditions:

- Priority will be given to students **whose field of studies is compatible with the field of studies in the Erasmus+ inter-institutional agreement** between the University of Warsaw and the partner university (see the attached list of the remaining free places).
- Students who were granted an Erasmus scholarship in the 1st round of qualifications (by 11 March 2016) are entitled to participate in the second round **only if they resign from the place granted in the first round, as well as the Erasmus funding. They can be granted a place in the second round without the Erasmus financial grant.**

2. Required documents

If you wish to apply in the second round of qualification please submit the following documents to the IRO:

2.1. Letter of motivation addressed to the IRO, in which you:

- a) name the host university where you would like to study **in the spring term** (you can choose **up to 2 universities** from the list); please **make sure that the university of your choice offers courses compatible with your field of studies** at the UW; If you apply for a place left by another department /faculty - **not compatible with your field of studies** - please specify the exact name of the department /faculty at the host university, where you would like to study.
- b) justify your choice of the host university/ universities

Your application must be endorsed (signed) by the Erasmus Departmental Coordinator at your home Institute /Department.

2.2. Document showing your GPA for the last academic year

2.3. Document certifying your level of the language of instruction, as required by the host university.

2.4. Declaration about any previous participation in the LLP Erasmus or Erasmus+ Programmes (please contact IRO about this document)

Please note! Include your current mobile number and email address in the letter of motivation.

Only complete applications will be accepted.

3. The deadline - the second round of qualifications runs until **31 October 2016**

4. Where to submit the documents

International Relations Office at the UW ;Krakowskie Przedmieście 26/28, Pałac Kazimierzowski (The Rectorate), 2nd floor, **room 28**.

The office is open **from 9.30 AM to 2 PM, from Monday to Thursday**.

5. Applications will be processed on an ongoing basis

IRO will contact the host university in order to nominate the student. Students will be informed individually (by email) about the decision of the host university.
