Josai International University's Policy on Accepting Students from Overseas  
in Response to the Japanese Government's Relaxing of Entry Restrictions

As the response to the new coronavirus pandemic continues, we know that your university is making concerted efforts to ensure that your students can continue their studies safely.

The Japanese Government decided to allow new foreign students from all countries and regions to enter Japan on October 1, 2020. This system assumes that the host university is responsible for the quarantine measures for foreign students entering Japan, and, therefore, we have been examining our arrangements for accepting foreign students.

Our basic policy is to ask international students to refrain from entering Japan until the measure requiring a 14-day quarantine period is lifted. However, for students who do wish to enter Japan as soon as possible, we have decided upon the following method and procedure.

[JIU student acceptance method]

- For 14 days upon arrival in Japan, students will be accommodated at a hotel in the vicinity of Narita Airport which can be booked through a company designated by JIU.
- JIU's contractor will support the implementation of quarantine measures for international students during the 14-day isolation period.
- JIU will contact each international student for information at the end of the quarantine period.
- JIU will bear the cost of outsourcing the work to the contractor.

[Conditions for accepting international students at JIU]

- Students sign a written agreement in which they commit to comply with the quarantine measures required by the Japanese Government and they shall submit such agreement to JIU.
- Each student is responsible for his or her own accommodation and meals during the quarantine period.

If, after confirming the details in the attached documents, there are foreign students who wish to enter Japan as soon as possible, we will send such students a Letter of Consent. Once we receive the signed Letter of Consent back from the students, we will send a Written Pledge so that they may obtain a visa. We will continue to share information and cooperate with our partner universities in order to manage the current difficult situation. We sincerely appreciate and value your continued support and cooperation.

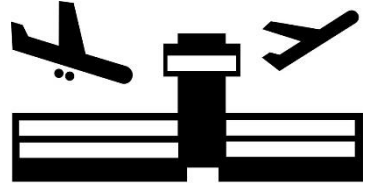

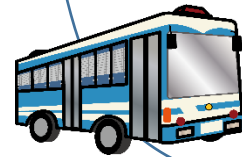

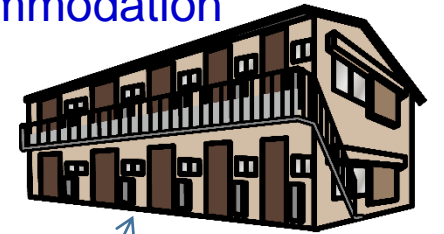
