

OLA at University of Warsaw – official statement by IRO

Dear Erasmus Partner,

This is an official statement of the International Relations Office of University of Warsaw with respect to **OLA (Online Learning Agreement)** for our **outgoing** Erasmus students.

We would like to kindly inform you that our **outgoing students (Autumn 21) will NOT be creating their Learning Agreements in OLA**. We are currently waiting for the EWP network to be fully connected with our home system (USOS), which will (hopefully) happen by July. From then onwards, our students' LAs should be available for you to sign in the Dashboard (or in your own system, if you are connected to EWP).

We would, therefore, like to kindly ask you not to make OLA mandatory for our (Autumn) students to be accepted as Erasmus students. If a Learning Agreement is required by your institution in the student application process, please accept a "traditional" pdf file provided by our students (generated from our home system) in this short transition period.

It is worth noting, that University of Warsaw is a member of the **OLA 3.0 Project Consortium** and has been very actively involved in developing the EWP network.

We will appreciate your understanding of our procedures in these few challenging transition months and we are looking forward to seeing EWP work!
