The International Relations Office (IRO UW) informs that Vice-Rector for Students and Quality of Teaching Prof. Sławomir Żółtek has agreed to pay out grants for the summer semester to students* who declared by 10.12.2021 an intention to extend their mobilities.

Therefore, students who extend their mobility (and continue their physical presence at the host university) are entitled to a scholarship in the same amount per month as in the first semester, for a period of up to 11 months.

After obtaining the approval of the Dean, the Head of the Faculty and / or the Erasmus Coordinator, IRO UW will contact you and send you an annex to your grant agreement.

Please, send your annex to the agreement by traditional post (the original copy).

Please note: The scholarship for the extended mobility period will be paid out on your request when:

- a) you post the **original** of the annex to the agreement to IRO UW;
- b) you notify IRO UW that you have edited your e-LA for the second semester in your USOSweb and that the courses have been approved online by the coordinator;
- c) you send a scan of your **Certificate of Attendance and Results**, completed and signed by the host University to IRO UW (the form is available here: http://bwz.uw.edu.pl/dla-studentow-i-doktorantow-studia-2021-2022/).

Attention! The remaining 10% installment of the overall scholarship will be paid out, according to the grant agreement, after the appraisal of your mobility.
