

IRO Announcement no 6/22/SMS/2022/2023

“Erasmus – Mobility for studies (KA131/2022)”

Financed from KA131/2022 project

National Agency of the Erasmus+ Programme and the European Solidarity Corps (NA) has informed us that financial agreements with students accepted for studies in Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Denmark, France, Greece, Spain, the Netherlands, Finland, Ireland, Iceland, Luxembourg, Malta, Germany, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Italy will be signed in September at the earliest.

In view of this situation, students who have sufficient financial means to receive the grant with a delay, are kindly asked to wait until IRO announces the possibility to sign the agreements (it will be possible to send us the agreement by post).

Students who cannot start their mobility without the grant may receive funds from the project KA131 / 2021, in which the scholarship is **lower by 30 EUR/month** compared to the KA131 / 2022 project and amounts to:

520 EUR/month or

770 EUR/month for students with a disability (having a disability certificate) and students who declared they were entitled to a UW social benefit.

We would like to confirm that it is possible to postpone the mobility to the second semester or shorten a full-year mobility to just one semester (second semester) on condition that the home department and the host university agree to this change.

If you decide to resign from the KA131/22 funding and would like to receive the 2021 grant or you would like to change the semester of your mobility, please send an email to m.kostecka@adm.uw.edu.pl.

After signing the financial agreement it will not be possible to revert back to the KA131/22 funding so we kindly ask you to make an informed decision.
