

IRO Announcement nr8/22/SMS/2022/2023
“Erasmus – Mobility for studies (KA131/2022)”
Academic year 2022/23 with the KA131/2022 funding

The European Commission has changed the template of the Erasmus grant agreement for students receiving funding from the KA131/2022 Project, which refers to students nominated to the following countries: Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Denmark, France, Greece, Spain, The Netherlands, Finland, Ireland, Iceland, Luxembourg, Malta, Germany, Norway, Portugal, Sweden and Italy. Consequently, the new EU template of the grant agreement for students is now awaiting the approval of the UW Legal Office, which means that IRO UW will be able to sign the grant agreements with students in the first half of October, at the earliest.

We would like to remind you that it is still possible to sign the financial agreement and receive the funding from the KA131/2021 Project, where the grant amount is 30 EUR less than in the KA131/2022 Project and amounts to: **520 EUR per month** or **770 EUR per month** for students with a disability and students receiving a UW social benefit.

If you wish to resign from the funding assigned to the KA131/2022 Project and wish to receive the grant from the KA131/2021 Project, please contact m.kostecka@adm.uw.edu.pl.

Please note that after signing the financial agreement with the funding from the KA131/2021 Project it will not be possible to switch to the KA131/2022 Project and receive the higher grant.
