GENERAL INFORMATION

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

To be enrolled as a regular student at home university and meet the required GPA by home university.

PROGRAM DURATION

One (1) semester, which may be extended to one (1) additional semester. (Maximum 1 year).

SPANISH COURSE

International students can take the *pre-movilidad* Spanish Course. The cost varies and can be confirmed writing to this email: spanishcourses@javeriana.edu.co

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Certificate a **B1 level** of Spanish as a minimum, according to the Common European Framework.

ACADEMIC INFORMATION

1. The **internship** program and **thesis** courses are **not** covered in the exchange program.
2. Javeriana's **grading scale** is from 0,0 to 5,0. 5,0 being the highest score and 3,0 the passing grade.
3. An academic credit is equivalent to a total of **48 hours** of academic work.
4. Full time study corresponds to an average of **17-20 academic credits** per semester.
5. Exchange students whose first language is not Spanish are advised to take between **10 and 12 credits** per semester.

APPLICATION PROCESS

THE STUDENT WILL RECEIVE THE ACCEPTANCE LETTER A MONTH AFTER THE OPENING CLOSES

- Feb 1st - Apr 14th, 2023: for studies in the second half of 2023 (Jul - Nov)
 Aug 1st - Oct 14th, 2023: for studies in the first half of 2024 (Jan - Jun)
 Feb 1st - Apr 14th, 2024: for studies in the second half of 2024 (Jul - Nov)

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

1. Official **nomination letter** issued by Home university.
2. **Motivation letter** (1 page) stating the reasons why you want to study at Pontificia Universidad Javeriana.
3. **Certificate of academic course grades** (transcript of records, ToR) issued by Home University. If applying for master program, please include undergrad ToR.
4. **Certificate of Spanish language** proficiency (level B1) for students whose first language is not Spanish and B2 English level to take courses in English.
5. Copy of valid **passport**.

The learning agreement is subject to approval by each Program Director at Javeriana and the availability of places for each course.

DOCUMENTS FOR ENROLMENT

VISA OR STAY PERMIT

The candidate must contact or visit the nearest Colombian embassy/consulate to find out the type of permit required for their exchange.

If the student's exchange will last a year, they must request a one-year acceptance letter.

INTERNATIONAL MEDICAL INSURANCE

The student must have, for the whole length of stay, an international traveling insurance (health/accidents) when they arrive in Colombia, with international coverage, that includes COVID-19 and with repatriation in case of death.



USEFUL INFORMATION

ACCOMMODATION

The University does not have student accommodation, but it does provide advice for finding accommodation in the city. The estimated monthly accommodation cost is between **USD \$200 and USD \$500**, depending on whether the accommodation rented is just a room or an entire apartment. OTHER EXPENSES

The monthly cost for food is approximately **USD \$180**. Books, transportation and other expenses are estimated to be **USD \$70** per month.
