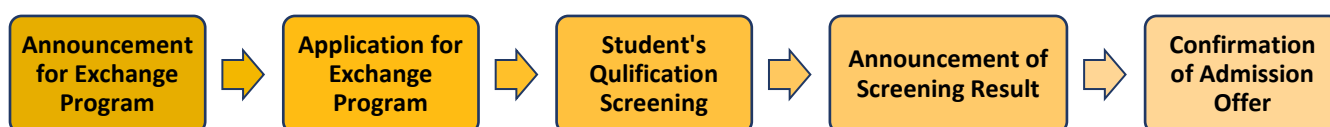

Required Course Load	
Minimum Number of Courses	Exchange students are required to enroll in at least one course provided by the Host Department and one course of GCP (Global Culture Programs) .
Maximum Credit Load	Undergraduate: maximum 27 credits in one semester Postgraduate: maximum 18 credits in one semester
* One semester consists of 16 weeks. 1 hour of lecture/tutorial per week or 2-3 hours laboratory/fieldwork per week for a whole semester results in 1 credit.
