


How to register to courses at the University of Warsaw?


a guide for short-term students

We understand that using new tools can be stressful and challenging, especially when you want to be extremely cautious, because your academic goals are at stake. Also, no need to deny that USOSweb looks scary and overwhelming at first sight. But worry not! We have some screenshots to share with you to dispel the doubts you might have.




In your application on the IRK platform you selected courses you wish to attend at UW. **Please note that this was just a preselection for recruitment purposes only!** Based on that you got accepted by the mobility coordinator and admitted at our University.

The most binding thing is to be registered for all the courses you are attending in USOSweb. **Only the courses that you are registered on in USOSweb will appear on your Transcript of Records!**



For Erasmus & Exchange students, **the registration opens shortly before the semester starts (the dates may vary at different units).** If you are a full year student, then in September you register to first semester and full year courses only; for second semester courses you will register in January/February.



Important: (Online/Digital) Learning Agreement is not a registration. If you want to add/delete a course, make sure to do the changes in your registration as well – and vice versa.

Your (O/D)LA must reflect your USOS registrations.



REGISTRATION STEP BY STEP

1. Create a list of courses you would like to attend in the upcoming semester

In your application submitted at the IRK platform you have chosen some courses. It was a **preselection** needed for recruitment purposes only - you have applied and based on that you were admitted, **you cannot edit your IRK course list anymore**.

You can, however, use it to create a list for registration. You might have been asked to change some courses (because they are thesis seminars/PhD classes/etc), others might not be given this semester. If you need to find replacements or if you'd simply like to consult your course list, don't hesitate to **contact the mobility coordinator** of the unit that offers the course.

- preferred group (if there are options to choose from)




Your USOSweb credentials were uploaded on your IRK profile (section “files to download”):

- **Username:** a unique sequence of 11 digits, usually starting with 007
- **Password:** the same as the one you created on the IRK platform

attendance is obligatory at most of
the courses – usually, only up to two
absences per semester are allowed (the
lecturer will inform you about the rules
at the beginning of the course). **It will
not be possible to participate in two
or more courses held at the same
time.** Make sure no courses are
overlapping in your timetable!

It's important to check also
**where the courses are taking
place.** For example, Faculty of
Economic Sciences and Faculty of
Management are almost 45
minutes apart - you won't be
able to travel between
campuses during one 15-minute
break!

To register for Additional Study Offer Courses, you need tokens - USOS currency with which you "pay" for the additional courses.

IRO UW grants you enough tokens to register for:

- **one** Polish Language Course - **POL** tokens
- Polonicum lectures about Polish culture - **OGP** tokens
- **one** Foreign Language Course (other than Polish) - **LEK** tokens
- **one** sports class - **WF** tokens
- general university courses (code:-OG) - **OG** tokens

- “regular” courses: check on website [Course registration by faculty](#) or contact the [mobility coordinator](#)
- token courses: check on website [Additional study offer](#) or visit the [token registration](#) section of USOS

Limits of ECTS:

- max. per semester - **30 ECTS**
- max. per academic year - **60 ECTS**
- **minimum one course is required**

At most of the units it is possible to register for courses **only within the first few weeks of the semester**. Remember that other students may wish to join the same class, so do not wait till the end of the registration period, as places may already be taken.

If the course you want to attend is full (there are no places available), please contact the [Mobility Coordinator](#) of the unit offering the course(s) in question - sometimes it is possible to be added manually

If you're not sure how many ECTS you have to bring home, please reach out to your home university and adhere to their regulations

We understand that sometimes it's hard to find the right course equivalents, therefore we have the flexibility of 10%. This means that we are willing to accept **33 ECTS** per semester (**66 ECTS** per academic year). **If you need more than that**, a special permission must be granted - IRO will contact you with more details few weeks into the semester.

DECIDED AGAINST TAKING THE COURSE YOU REGISTERED TO?

Don't worry, within the first days of the semester you can unregister the same way you registered:

- by clicking on the cart in USOSweb/Token USOS
- by contacting the mobility coordinator who registered you to the course


Unregister from the courses you decided to drop - thanks to that you won't block your spot and another student might be able to register and attend the course!

Unregistration is possible **as long as the registration is open**. Once the registration period is closed, you will not be able to unregister from a course. It will stay on your account in USOSweb even if you do not attend it. **At the end you will get a statutory fail grade for this class on your transcript of records.**

Please remember that deleting a course in your (Online) Learning Agreement does not mean that you will be automatically unregistered from the course in USOSweb!

TOO LATE TO UNREGISTER?

Every UW student is allowed to give up passing ONE course during their studies at UW. This can be done in USOSweb, under the STUDENT'S SECTION > Linkage> Resign:



The option is available within the deadline set in the academic calendar. **You will not obtain any grade from the course and it will not be included in the Transcript of Records.**

IF YOU HAVE ANY PROBLEMS WITH COURSE REGISTRATION OR NEED ADVICE REGARDING COURSE SELECTION – PLEASE CONTACT THE MOBILITY COORDINATOR AT THE UNIT OFFERING THE COURSE(S) IN QUESTION.

(Online) Learning Agreement is not registration.

If you want to add/delete a course, make sure to do the changes in your registration as well!

And vice versa: you made changes in your registrations? **Don't forget to update your (O)LA!**

Before the start of your mobility, we organise a **webinar on course registration**.

During the Orientation Week we organise a **Course Registration Support session** in face-to-face mode; you can visit us with your laptop and we will try to find a solution.
