



English Proficiency on at least **B2 level** according to CEFR scale (or equivalent)

The knowledge of English may be certified by following documents:

- International Baccalaureate Diploma, European Baccalaureate Diploma or Polish maturity exam in English language at advanced level (“new maturity diploma”) with result of at least 60%
- A document issued abroad recognised to be **equivalent with a high school diploma** - provided that the document clearly states the programme was delivered exclusively in English and that it meets the requirements of Education Authorities in Poland
- Certificate on completion of Foundation Year at the University of Warsaw
- Recommendation of the Centre of Foreign Language Teaching UW issued after participation in the Central Foreign Language Proficiency Examination (CFLPE) – register at Kampus e-learning platform
- University Council for the Coordination of Foreign Language Teaching and Language Proficiency Certification
- **An official document issued in English by student’s home institution** encompassing all four components (reading, writing, speaking, listening) and clearly stating student’s level of English
- University of Warsaw Language Proficiency Form, signed by student’s home institution
